JACKSON LAWYER WINS \$18M DAMAGES

The BBC News reported that the former lawyers for Michael Jackson were awarded \$20.25 million in damages against an air charter firm that secretly taped the pop star and his attorneys during a November 2003 flight. "This is an important day for lawyers who generally represent celebrities and high profile people," said Brian Kabateck, the Kabateck Brown Keller LLP partner who represented Jackson's attorneys, Mark Geragos and Pat Harris.
