

Los Angeles Times - **Firms That Employed Metrolink Engineer Had Other Troubles**

The Los Angeles Times recounted various complaints against Veolia Transportation, the French company that runs transit systems throughout the U.S. and Europe, including charges that its buses and trains were late, that it had a poor safety and training record and kept spotty records. Veolia operated the Metrolink train that collided with a Union Pacific train in Chatsworth in September 2008. The Times also noted that Brian Kabateck of Kabateck Brown Kellner LLP has a federal class action against the company charging that the company did not always give its drivers required lunch or rest breaks. "To us it's about the safety of the driver and the passenger," Kabateck said.
