FROM WARREN TO ROBERTS, A CHANGING COURT

Richard Kellner of Kabateck Brown Kellner wrote a book review on Erwin Chemerinsky's new book, "The Conservative Assault on The Constitution," that was published in the Los Angeles Daily Journal on December 30. In his review, Kellner notes that the U.C. Irvine Law School Dean points to the ascendance of conservative courts beginning with the Nixon administration and the resulting erosion of important and fundamental rights.

"Chemerinsky provides a compelling argument that while the conservative justices claims to be strict constructionists who adhere to the "original meaning" of the constitution, their rulings are functionally identical to the ideologically-driven judicial activism of their liberal counterparts," Kellner writes.
