PELLICANO CONVICTED OF RACKETEERING

Daily Variety reported that a federal jury convicted celebrity private investigator Anthony Pellicano of 76 of the 77 charges against him, including racketeering, identify theft and conspiracy to intercept telephone calls or use wiretaps. The jury also convicted four co-defendants. The newspaper quoted Brian Kabateck, managing partner of Kabateck Brown Keller LLP and lead counsel in the civil cases against Pellicano.

“The Pellicano saga is far from over,” Kabateck said. “While there is satisfaction in seeing him found guilty for his crimes, we look forward to the civil process helping find justice for his victims and punishment for those who aided Pellicano’s conspiracy but escaped prosecution in the criminal courts.”
